Summary of the course evaluation

Unfortunately only 8 students answered even though we encouraged them to do this. The students were satisfied with the course, the averages on the various questions varied between 4.1 and 4.5. The teachers' own question about how well we succeeded with our goals for the course got 4.4. The few negative comments were about Canvas (new for the teachers) or the rapid change to online teaching.

Comments from the teachers team

Major Very much extra work going online with short notice. Canvas, Zoom and the art of recording lectures in Powerpoint were all new to the teachers which sometimes made things a bit chaotic.

Evaluation and changes made since the previous course

None since the previous course was much better as it was given live. We barely managed to adjust to the online conditions in due time.

Suggested changes for the next course

Unfortunately also this years' course will have to be given online. This time, however, we will try to the excursions since they are an appreciated part of the course.
