Summary of the course evaluation

Overall the students were pleased with the course (grade 4.4 ± 0.5). The students appreciated the different forms of learning activities: seminars, Risk Assessment project, and Applied literature project, and study visits. Also appreciated that projects were current and relevant for society. Some students wished for more supervision on projects and more "background knowledge" on ecotoxicology and statistics.

Comments from the teachers team

The course worked out reasonably well, apart from the abrupt end (COVID) which hampered feedback sessions on projects.

Evaluation and changes made since the previous course

Due to last years comments from students, more consulting sessions and workshops were added relating to the two projects. It seems this facilitated learning as the student got started earlier developing project structure.

Suggested changes for the next course

For next year, additional presentation technique sessions focussing on report writing and literature review will be added, to facilitate learning on reading and writing from a scientific perspective. A module on meta-analysis will also be added.
